Arti u kultura aċċessibbli għal kulhadd permezz tal-maltabiennale.art

Matul tmiem il-ġimgħa, il-maltabiennale.art introduċa offerta speċjali hekk kif ingħata skont ta' 50% fuq il-prezzijiet tad-dħul fis-siti ta' Heritage Malta, li fihom qed jidhru x-xogħlijiet tal-biennale. Ir-rispons kien kbir, u kienu bosta dawk li ħerqanin esploraw imkejjien ikoniċi bħalm'huma l-Palazz tal-Gran Mastru, il-Mużew Nazzjonali tal-Arkeoloġija, il-MUŻA, il-Forti Sant'Anġlu, u t-Tempji tal-Ġgantija, fost oħrajn.
