Il-President tar-Repubblika pprezentata bil-katalogu tal-Biennale

Il-President tar-Repubblika, l-Eċċellenza Tagħha Myriam Spiteri Debono, ġiet ipprezentata bil-katalogu uffiċjali tal-maltabiennale.art. Din il-preżentazzjoni saret proprju fil-Park Arkeoloġiku tal-Ġgantija fejn l-Eċċellenza Tagħha l-President ta' Malta żaret installazzjoni tal-arti kontemporanja parti mill-istess biennale.

Fil-Ġgantija l-President tar-Repubblika ntlaggħet miċ-Chairman ta' Heritage Malta u President tal-Malta Biennale, is-Sur Mario Cutajar.

Il-President tar-Repubblika żaret l-installazzjoni tal-arti kontemporanja Ibrahim Mahama li ġgħib l-isem ta' 'Decolonising Malta: Polyphony is Us'. L-artist mill-Ghana juża t-trasformazzjoni tal-materjali biex jittratta temi bħall-migrazzjoni, il-globalizzazzjoni u l-iskambju ekonomiku. Mahama huwa artist ta' kalibru internazzjonali, fil-fatt wirjiet tiegħu ġew esebiti f'avvenimenti mxerdin mal-erbat irjieħ tad-dinja, inkluż f'Sydney l-Awstralja, fil-biennale ta' Venezia, f'Cape Town fl-Afrika t'Isfel u f'Tel Aviv l-Iżrael, f'Kopenħagen id-Danimarka fost oħrajn.

Din kienet it-tieni żjara tal-President Spiteri Debono matul dan l-ewwel biennale Malti li kulmajmur qed jġgħbed attenzjoni globali waqt li poġġa lil Malta fuq il-mappa dinjija tal-arti kontemporanja tant li ġgħbed volumi kbar ta' viżitaturi f'kull avveniment tiegħu.

maltabiennale.art hija inizzjattiva tal-Heritage Malta permezz ta' MUŻA, il-Mużew Nazzjonali tal-Arti, bi sħubija mal-Kunsill Malti tal-Arti. *maltabiennale.art* hija pprezentata wkoll b'kollaborazzjoni mal-Ministeru tal-Affarijiet Barranin u Ewropej u l-Kummerċ, mal-Ministeru għall-Wirt Nazzjonali, l-Arti u l-Gvern Lokali, mal-Ministeru ta' Għawdex, kif ukoll ma' Visit Malta, Malta Libraries, MCAST, Festivals Malta, L-Aġenzija Kulturali għall-Belt Valletta u Spazju Kreattiv. L-inizzjattiva tinkludi s-sehem tal-iskola tal-Arti Viżiva u Performattiva f'Malta, AUM, ŻfinMalta, KorMalta, Teatru Manoel, L-Orkestra Filarmonika ta' Malta, Franco La Cecla, IULM University Milan, id-Dipartiment tal-Istudji Umanistiċi, il-Fakultà tal-Arti u Turizmu, id-Dipartiment tal-Wirt Kulturali ta' Taħt il-Baħar ta' Heritage Malta, id-Dipartiment Arkeoloġiku ta' Heritage Malta u l-Mużew Marittimu ta' Heritage Malta.

President presented with Malta Biennale official catalogue

During her visit to an exhibition as part of the Malta Biennale at the Ġgantija Archaeological Park, the President of Malta Her Excellency Myriam Spiteri Debono received the official catalogue of the maltabiennale.art.

The President was welcomed in Ġgantija by Mr Mario Cutajar, Chairperson of Heritage Malta and President of the maltabiennale.art.

The catalogue's presentation to the President was made as Her Excellency visited the exhibition entitled 'Decolonising Malta: Polyphony is Us' by artist Ibrahim Mahama from Ghana. Mahama's installations include material transformation to touch on issues of migration, commodity, globalisation and economic exchange. Ibrahim Mahama's art is world renowned given his installations in Sydney, Cape Town, Copenhagen, Tel Aviv and Venice amongst others.

Ġgantija's was the second visit by President Spiteri Debono to the maltabiennale.art as the first Maltese biennale continues to attract the attention of international media houses whilst placing Malta on the global map for contemporary art.

maltabiennale.art is a Heritage Malta initiative through MUŻA, the Malta National Community Art Museum, in partnership with Arts Council Malta. maltabiennale.art is also presented in cooperation with the Ministries for Foreign and European Affairs and Trade, National Heritage, the Arts and Local Government, and Gozo, as well as with Visit Malta, Malta Libraries, MCAST, Festivals Malta, Valletta Cultural Agency and Spazju Kreattiv.
